

CELEBRATIONS

Gandhi Jayanti

Halloween

Halloween is celebrated every year on October 31. The tradition originated with the ancient Celtic festival of Samhain, when people would light bonfires and wear costumes to ward off ghosts. The day Marked the end of summer and the harvest and the beginning of dark, cold winter. In Scotland and Ireland, young people took part in a tradition called guising, dressing up in costumes and accepting offerings from various hoseholds. They would sing a song, tell a joke or perform anyother sort of "trick" before collecting their "treat" which consisted of fruits, candies or coins.

We celebrated Halloween this year on October 29. Children were made aware about the festival and they enjoyed the activity "trick and

Through sensorial work the child can acquire clear information and then be able to make classifications in his environment. Sensorial exercises were designed by Montessori to cover every quality that can be perceived by the senses such as size, shape, texture, matching and

much more.





















Project: Nursery- Birds

The unit of inquiry in the form of project of the month was 'Birds'found in every part of the world. The students were made aware about
different types of birds through individual as well as group activities.
They were able to differentiate various kinds of birds, their babies &
homes. They took interest in feeding birds in a bird feeder. They also
enjoyed writing with a feather. Videos, crafts, rhyme, activities &
conversation on birds enhanced their knowledge.











Project: KG-Solar System

The solar system includes the sun and all the objects that orbit around it due to its gravity. This includes things such as planets, comets, asteroids, meteoroids and moons. Our kids learnt about Solar system through videos, planet song, keeping planets in order etc. They enjoyed planets craft activity. It was a very informative and creative activity. They were also acquainted to our unique planet 'Earth'. They all learnt the names of the planets in the correct sequence. They made the solar system craft with great enthusiasm.











Sub-Project: Nursery-Insects

The teacher introduced the enthusiastic tiny tots into the world of

'INSECTS'. All insects have three parts: the head, the Thorax (which is the middle part) and the abdomen. The students were made aware about harmful insects and useful insects, their kinds and uses etc. They keenly learnt about insects by doing different activities on insects.










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


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Languages

English

Pre Nursery: Our kids learnt to recognize the letter sounds 's' and 'a'. They were able to associate the letter sounds with the pictures. They were taught through songs and stories. They learnt through orals, tracing, games, matching and by making the letter sound activity.

.Nursery: Tiny Tots of this class learnt to recognize, pronounce & to write letter sounds a to z. They were taught to write letter names A to F. They were able to match letter sounds to the letter names and the pictures. They learnt to code and read short sound words with a, o, e, i. as a middle sound. They had learnt all this through writing, orals, tracing and various activities. They also practiced the dictation of sounds.

KG: The children of this class learnt to read and write words of long sounds-ai, ee, oa. They did the dictation as well. They also learnt the concept of This-That, jumbled words, Kangaroo words, tricky words, making sentences by live examples. They learnt all this by reading, writing and doing different activities











Hindi

<u>Pre Nursery</u>: Our tiny tots learnt to speak & pronounce correctly in Hindi. They enjoyed reciting Rhymes and the names of body parts in Hindi.

Nursery: Our kids learnt to write Hindi swars इ, ई ,ए,ऐ in Hindi. They were able to associate swars with pictures. They had done the recap of swars अ to ऐ। They enjoyed reciting Hindi rhymes.

KG: The children learnt to read and write words and sentences using three letters. The children were able to frame and write sentences. They were able to pronounce words and associating with the picture. They enjoyed different activities in Hindi such as-drawing pictures starting from the letter, matching pictures to words and letter etc.











Number Work

<u>Pre Nursery</u>: The tiny tots learnt number 1 through various activities. They were able to draw quantities according to the number. They associated the number to the quantity.

Numbers 31 to 37 and associating to the quantities. They were able to write numbers 1-30 in sequence and also the houses of 10 and 20. They were able to form quantities till 30. They learnt to identify the smallest and the biggest number among the given numbers.

KG: The children learnt numbers up to 100 and different concepts for numbers 1-70 like forming quantities, before, after and between. They started with the number names beyond 10 and the concept of comparing numbers by using signs <, >, =. Activities enhanced their learning.













Art & Craft

If your kids love digging into arts and crafts projects with paint or glue up to their elbows, relax -- they're learning and developing in essential ways while they're making a beautiful mess. Children derive many important benefits from the opportunity of working with arts and crafts projects. They enjoyed art & craft work by making various crafts related projects and sub-projects.





















Story sessions

The children watched the various stories according to their project and sub project.

The children of class Nursery enjoyed the stories 'कबूतर और मधुमक्खी' and 'The Thirsty Crow'. The children of class KG enjoyed the stories 'हवा और सूरज' and 'Unity is strength'. The teachers explained the stories during online using story cards and to the students present in the class as well.. Then the reinforcement of stories was done on Zoom app by respective class incharges. All kids gave a wonderful response. They took interest in doing worksheets as well. Some children told the story in their own words.









Flameless Cooking

Every month children enjoy flameless cooking. This month they learnt to make coconut ladoos and their nutritional value. They were encouraged to eat homemade sweets too.
