You can download the **Jolly Phonics teacher's app**. It will also help them to understand in a better way.






Jesus came back to visit his friends and disciples. He told them to teach about God's love. He said, "Tell the people to believe in me, even if they can't see me."

Baisakhi Festival is mainly celebrated in North India as the "Punjabi New Year". The day of Baisakhi is considered one of the most important days among the Punjabi community. The Sikh people start the celebration by visiting the Gurdwara. It is also celebrated by other people.

Farmers offer thanks to God and pray for the good crops in future. Baisakhi is a time for reunion of friends and families and people distribute food and clothes to the poor people.

5) Baisakhi is the festival of joy and happiness, and this major celebration takes place in Punjab.


6) The festival starts with the Bhangra and Gidda performance by men and women.
